Curriculum

Language Arts

We have finished up our work with writing newspaper articles and will begin working on story writing again. We will also be working to develop our comprehension and reading strategies through Reading Theory. We encourage your child to use Read Theory from home for additional test taking practice.

Math

We are finishing our unit on patterns and tables of value and moving on to Data Analysis and Probability. Remember to encourage your child to use their Mathletics.ca account. It's a great way to review concepts! In addition, please continue to practice the Math Part 'A'

Health

In April we will be studying healthy relationships and conflict resolution between peers and among families.

Science

We will explore the characteristics of air and the interaction between moving air and solids. We will examine how air is a compressible fluid, that it is composed of many gases, and that moving air can support solid materials in sustained flight. By studying birds and airplanes, we learn a variety of adaptations and designs that make flight possible and that provide for propulsion and control.

Social Studies

We are learning the Provincial Government and taking part in Student Vote. The students have been researching the party platforms and candidates for Calgary-Currie. Students will be voting on Monday April 15th. It will be interesting to see how close our results are compared to the election. Our last unit will be Ancient Greece. Please continue to work on your slideshow as good preparation for the year-end study guide.

During the month of April, the French 6 students will be introduced to the topic: "La Province de l'Alberta." They will learn to identify and describe where they live within the province, as well as the various types of landscapes and animals found here.
