Agendas

Homework Expectations

Homework is an important part of learning. Here are a few things you'll want to know.

- Approx. one week's notice will be given to study for a unit test. Often, a study guide will be sent home as well. Small quizzes will be given less notice.
- If homework is not completed we may ask you to complete it during recess time.
- 20 minutes of daily reading is expected.
- Students are expected to practice math 3 times a week using their Mathletics account. Students have been given their passwords during the first week of school.
- Regular practice of PAT part A (multiplication, division, addition and subtraction) will be given to all students monthly during math classes.
- Occasionally, unfinished work will be sent home.
